 - We can make a list of newer options as well
- We need to show 24 movies for contract, we are currently at about 10
- We had a near three-way tie for the older movie at the last weekend
 - Jurassic Park
 - Rogue One
 - Jaws was close, but was selected for the other old movie weekend
- We can vote now
 - Jurassic Park 15
 - Rogue One 5

Publicity/Money Situation

- We need more people to come to our shows
- We are not breaking even with money
- Talk to profs who teach intro classes to give passes out/advertise us in their classes
- Suggestions we have been given:
 - Raise prices for tickets and concessions
 - Tickets for community members specifically?
 - Raising prices could upset/drive away customers
 - We pay almost \$1 per some candy
 - Would it save money to use smaller bags of popcorn?
 - Popcorn oil does cost money
 - · Less of each batch goes to waste
 - We won't save that much money
 - Could we keep stricter inventory of what we sell?
 - This would let us know how popular each item is
 - We could save money on items people don't buy as much
 - We could stock more of the popular items
 - Make a spreadsheet
 - We can extrapolate from what Tyler buys more frequently
 - Increase advertisements with other people
 - Have people make videos
 - Video ads make more money for us
 - Faculty-led study abroad has reached out to us about videos before
 - Apparently a lot of students don't know about Film Board
 - Talk to them
 - Bring up Film Board whenever you can
- New locations for table tents
 - Sitting area in DOW?
 - Café?
 - They throw them out at the end of the night
 - Something sized between flyers and posters on bulletin boards
 - Flyers in Hillside
- Megaphone & Red wagon to advertise
- Make movie showings more like events
 - Free options to try and draw bigger crowds
 - o Movie trivia?
 - Use popcorn as an incentive

- Outdoor projection to draw attention
 - o Can we do this?
 - o Winter Carnival screen failed miserably last time
 - o Better idea for warmer weather
