Free Solo

- We will get it for free
- It will not be this weekend
 - Will be after Spring Break
 - o Two shows during the weekend?
 - Not on the same day
 - Two 5:30 shows?
 - Both Sunday shows?
 - Don't do 5:30 on Sunday (unless doing all of Sunday) in case people show up for our regular movie
 - This way they can come back for the regular movie at a later time
 - Overall, we are okay with doing 2 showings of Free Solo, specifics TBD

Ideas for signing up on the board

- Option 1: Keep things the same
- Option 2: At the beginning of each meeting, the board will be at the front table.
 Sign up as you walk in, and then empty shows will be filled in while the board is passed around
- Option 3: Same as usual, but people missing meetings can't ask for specific shows, only days they are available
- Thoughts:
 - If people ask for specific shows, put a dot by those shows
 - Won't stop people at the meeting from signing up for them
 - Those who are less concerned with getting shows will know what to leave open
 - Do one round of the board, then fill up shows from people who are gone
 - Some people have expressed general support for each option
 - Putting the board at the front helps people with fewer available times to work shows
 - People who come in earlier would have an advantage for signing up
 - Right now, those sitting close to Isaiah have an advantage
 - Support for the idea that the board still goes around once before the people who are gone fill in the shows
 - Most people like the idea of having the board at the front in the beginning, then Isaiah fills in people who are missing, then pass the board around
 - Trial period of this method?

- Morgan entertains a motion for Isaiah to leave board at the front until about 6:10, then fill in absent members' requests, then send the board around
 - Josh moves
 - Brendan seconds
 - Four abstentions, the rest in favor
